"19b...Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. 21 Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you." (John 20) "36 While they were talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." (Luke 24)

John 20:19b & 21 and Luke 24:36 both contain Jesus' words to his disciples of "Peace be with you." This sentence is a desire for their turmoil and uncertainty to be laid aside for the blessing of peace.

At both Nazareth and United we pass the peace every Sunday. This usually follows the sermon and prayers. Often it becomes a "Hello, how are you?" among many. I want to remind you what this moment is about: that the peace is not just a greeting but a blessing upon the other, an extension of divine shalom – wholeness, well-being – that God gives, through us, to the people around us. I encourage you to change what you say if it helps: instead of "Peace be with you," perhaps say "May you know the peace Christ gives" or "I wish you God's peace today and always." This is the peace we truly seek. This is the peace Jesus gave his followers after the resurrection and gives us today.

Remind us again today, risen Jesus, that you are our peace. Amen. (This devotion is adapted from <u>Christ in Our Home</u> April, May, June 2024 for Sunday, April 14. It was originally written by Pastor Jay Gamelin.)

(as of 4/25/24)


Our monthly budgeted income for 2024 is projected to be \$10,583.34. The below numbers show our actual offering totals for April.
